Nestled among the lush greenery of Kent Ridge Park, the National Community Leadership Institute (NACLI) is the community leadership development arm of the People's Association.

Established on 5 October 1964, NACLI's key purpose is in "leadership training aimed at instilling in leaders a sense of national identity and a spirit of dedicated service to a multi-racial community" with a mission to develop, align and inspire leaders in building and bridging communities.

The upgraded four-hectare campus is now equipped with 300-seater auditorium, an air-conditioned dining hall, over 20 training rooms, 3 residential lodges which can house up to 160 participants and 2 main training blocks.

The training of community leaders comes about as NACLI provides training, facilitation and consultancy expertise on top of organising workshops, retreats, dialogues and forums. Such training and facilitation is done via an applied and practical approach – being fun, creative and experiential with low element adventure.
